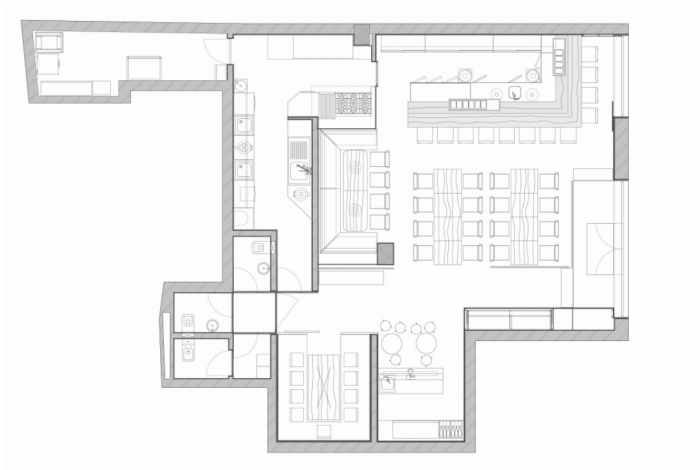

A signature sushi restaurant positioned to stage the world's leading Michelin-starred chefs

Located in Lisbon, the restaurant pays homage to chef Takashi Yoshitake's passion for Japanese traditional gastronomy.

Designed as an intimate and minimalist space intended as a club-restaurant and sake bar, it uses sliding panels and translucent fibre screens for flexibility and privacy. Simplicity in the use of diffused lighting and neutral colours of micro-cement floors, combine with natural materials, namely, the extensive use of walnut for the table tops and a ceiling made of wide timber joists. Green Bamboo marble counter tops, wall cladding and display shelving combine with show cooking areas in glazed handcrafted tiles and bronze glass mirrored partitions. The customized furniture is also in solid walnut with leather upholstery, as well as the large central table and Japanese style floor chairs.
